

**GULLEY GREENHOUSE, INC.      2006 RETAIL FRUIT TREES**

**Maximize Your Fruit Crop:**

Fruit trees should be planted in full sun to part sun. For the best fruit with the sweetest flavor, the trees need moist well-drained soil. To prevent a shallow root structure, fruit trees need to be watered deeply. Always remember to incorporate peat moss or other organic material into your soil when planting. Trees that are not self-pollinating need another tree for cross-pollination. The other tree must be the same type (apple-apple) but of a different variety (McIntosh-Red Delicious). Semi-dwarf fruit trees are preferred, because they usually produce fruit at an early age, and are easier to maintain. Most of our trees are semi-dwarf, unless otherwise noted. Our trees are also 3-5 years old, and should produce within a couple of years.

GALA	10-15'	Yes	Sept.	Red-Yellow	Dessert apple from New Zealand. Crisp, rich flavor. Good pollinator.
GOLDEN DELICIOUS	10-15'	Yes	Oct.	Yellow	Good as pollinator for other varieties. Good fresh and cooked.
HARALSON	10-15'	Yes	Oct.	Red	Tart, juicy, and crisp. Often bears the first year. Keeps well for 4-6 months.
HONEYCRISP	10-15'	No	Sept.	Red	Stores up to 5 months. Explosive crispness, flavor, and texture.
HONEYGOLD	10-15'	No	Oct.	Gold	Crisp, yellow, juicy flesh. Excellent storage qualities. Dessert and cooking.
JONATHAN	10-15'	Yes	Oct.	Red	Sweet, crisp, juicy flesh. Dessert and cooking. Medium size apple.
McINTOSH	10-15'	Yes	Sept.	Red	Commercial variety. Prolific bearer. Good fresh or cooked.
RED DELICIOUS	10-15'	No	Oct.	Red	Rich, sweet flavor to light yellow, crisp flesh. Good fresh or in salads.
RED FUJI	10-15'	Yes	Sept/Oct.	Red	Sweet, very crisp and flavorful, excellent keeper and pollinizer
SWEET 16	10-15'	No	Sept.	Dk. Red	Yellow, sweet, crisp, juicy flesh. Excellent dessert. Fireblight resistant. Cold hardy.
YELLOW DELICIOUS	10-15'		Sep/Oct	Gold/Yell	Medium size apple. Firm flesh, crisp and juicy Good for fresh eating or cooking.
ZESTA	10-15'	No	Sept.	Red	Summer apple that is sweet, crisp, and juicy. Storage life is 12 weeks.
<b>APRICOT Fruit not always reliable due to climate. Plant in cooler microclimate to delay flowering. Bears 5-7 yrs after planting.</b>					
CHINESE (MORMON)	8-10'	Yes	June	Pink-Orange	Small to medium fruit, sweet, <b>recommended for spring frost prone climates.</b>
HARCOT	8-10'	Yes	early-mid June	Yellow-Orange	Medium to large fruit, hardy lated bloom, resists brown rot and per. canker. Sweet, juicy, rich flavor
MOONGOLD	8-10'	No	July-Aug.	Orange	Semi-dwarf. Sweet juicy fruit. Freestone
MOORPARK, Semi	8-10'	Yes	July-Aug.	Gold-Red	Large fruit, red blush, sweet & juicy. Freestone. Good for canning and eating. Self-pollinating.
SCOUT	8-10'	No	Aug.	Gold	Fruit ripens in August, good for canning and jam. Blooms in May. Freestone.

<b>CHERRY- SOUR</b>	<b>Outstanding trees for landscape. Small size, attractive reddish bark, white spring flowers, summer fruit.</b>					
COMBO	8-10'	Yes	Var.	Mix	Four cherry trees grafted to one stem. Prolonged crop yield.	
BALI	8-10'	No	Aug.	Red	Hardy cherry from Canada. Good fresh. Not really considered a sweet cherry.	
METEOR	8-10'	Yes	July	Red	Large, bright red, mildly acidic fruit. Good for sauce or preserves.

BLACK TARTARIAN	10-12'	No	July	Purple	Large, purplish-black fruit. Juicy and very rich. Vigorous grower. Heavy bearer.	
LAPINS	10-12'	Yes	June	Dk. Red	Sweet cherry, large excellent flavor.	
MESABI	10-12'	Yes	July	Red	Red fleshed fruit. Good pie variety. Sugar content 1/2 between pie and Bing.	
RAINIER	10-12'	No	June	Yellow-Red	Sweet and flavorful. Cold hardy Yellow fruit, blushed red.	
STELLA	10-12'	Yes	July	Black	Sweet cherry with black skin and flesh. Best pollinator for other cherries.

VAN	10-12'	No	June	Red	Very cold hardy, reliable, heavy bearing cherry tree similar to the Bing.

HARKO	8-10'	Yes	July	Yellow	Sweet firm fruit, cold hardy, tolerant of bacterial spot and brown rot.	
DWARF	8-10'	Yes	July	Red	Genetic dwf. Bears med fruit w/red blush.	
<b>PEACH</b>	<b>Fruit production not always reliable due to climate. Plant in a protected, cooler microclimate.</b>					
COMBO	10-12'	Yes	Var.	Mix	Four peach trees grafted to one stem. Prolonged crop yield.	
CANADIAN HARMONY	10-12'	Yes	August	Blush Red	Medium to large fruit, excellent for freezing or eating fresh.	
ELBERTA	10-12'	Yes	Sept.	Yellow	Large, red-blushed golden fruit. Freestone. Juicy, tender flesh. Good fresh or cooked.	
FANTASTIC ELBERTA	10-12'	Yes	August	Yellow	Large fruit, pink blossoms, all purpose, can be eaten fresh, canned, frozen or dried.	
FAY ELBERTA	8-10'	Yes	August	Yellow	Juicy, moderately sweet can be eaten fresh, canned, frozen, dried.	
FROST	8-10'	Yes	July	Blush Red	Heavy bearing, resistant to leaf curl, excellent for canning or eaten fresh.	
HALE HAVEN	8-10'	Yes	Sept.	Yellow	Yellow fruit, blushed red. Ripens early. High yielding. Freestone. Good fresh or canned.

KIEFFER	25'	No	Oct.	Yellow	Bears large fruit at an early age. Blight resistant.	
WARREN	15-20'	Yes	August	Lt. Green to Red	Dessert pear, highly resistant to fire blight. Medium to large fruit, smooth flesh.

PIPESTONE	10-15'	Yes	Sept.	Red	Sweet juicy yellow flesh w/ excellent quality. Immense sized fruit. Good for fresh use & jam. Clingstone	
STANLEY	10-15'	Yes	Sept.	Blue	European plum. Semi-freestone. Large dark blue fruit with greenish yellow flesh. .	
SUPERIOR	10-15'	Yes	Sept.	Red	One of the best plums. Large red skinned fruit.	
TOKA	10-15'	No	Aug.	Red	Best pollinator. Rich flavored fruit. Clingstone.
