## Description

---

Large green heads. Most common variety.

---

Crisp, ultra-sweet wax beans in clusters on compact, unusually upright plants. High yields.

Flat pod bean.

Compact, bearing purple pencil thick pods which turn green when cooked.

---

Mid early green broccoli with large heavy head. Medium size beads with good dome shape.

Firm, dark green uniform buttons which crowd stems.

---

Chinese cabbage. Extra sweet and extra early. Oblong heads are 3-4".

Blue-green 'no waste' variety with small core and 4" round 2 pound heads.

Abundant produce of solid, globe-shaped cabbages. Excellently flavored heads that are slow to burst.

Solid 6 pound heads form early but keep growing.

---

### **Wow man! Purple carrots!!**

6" roots are uniformly cylindrical and core free.

---

Pure white 2 pound heads are protected from sun by upright growing leaves.

Self branching variety. Easier to grow.

---

Yellow and white kernels.

Yellow kernels.

Late season variety famous for flavor and quality.

---

Deep green with paler stripes 1½" across. Compact 2' vines. Very productive.

Monoecious, produces both male & female flowers for higher yield/longer. Semi-dwarf plants-compact. Dk green fruit avg. 8-9"

Pickling variety, very productive, disease tolerant.

Sets fruit much more freely and sooner than other slicers.

---

### **Elongated lavender fruit with white stripes 3-5" long.**

Long, Japanese type. Up to 12" long. Fruits are slender and easily sliced. Skin is dark purple.

Highest yielding eggplant of the Black Beauty oval type. Fruits are mild flavored and delicious.

Extremely frilled and curled edges.

Green skin, crisp white flesh.

---

Many exotic leaf shapes, textures and colors.

### **Butter head type, slow to bolt, bright green.**

Large open heads of tender thick green leaves. Crunchy, crisp texture.

### **Burgundy red, deeply lobed, oak-like leaves. Slow bolting.**

Exceptional quality and productivity.

---

Slightly oval fruit, heavily netted and ribbed. Deep orange flesh.

Green fleshed honey dew melon. Oval shaped fruit has smooth pale green skin without netting.

Large oval fruit. Pale yellow green when mature.

---

Out of this world taste. Tender pods are 3 1/3 - 5" long, attractive dark green.

---

Large bright red, globed shaped with attractive red and white flesh that has just the right taste for hamburgers.

Sweet white, delicious.

5" white flesh onion.

---

Flavor is good and blunt ended pods are born in pairs.

Edible pod snow pea. Light green, 4".

### **1 (mild) to 9 (hot) number to right of name.**

Dark green to red fruits with medium to thick walls.

Blunt tapered 1½" fruits rate twice as hot as a typical commercial habanero.

Long red, very wrinkled, green to red fruits about 6" x ¾". Thin flesh used for pickling or drying.

8-9" beautifully shaped green fruits with tremendous yields.

Ornamental as well as edible, fleshy pods especially good in oriental dishes and chili.

Hottest available. Green to yellow orange.  
Dark green fruit maturing to red. Walls are thick and pungent.  
**2006 AAS Winner. Early, superior size, high yields and mild taste.**  
**4" pepper like a super jalapeno.**  
Cherry shaped. Red.  
Club shaped fruit tapered at both ends. 2¼-2½". Turns green to red at maturity.

---

Very productive large light yellow fruit turns brilliant red when ripe.  
Tasty, sweet bells. Mostly 4 lobed, emerald green to bright red at maturity.  
**2006 AAS Winner. Produces 6" sweet Italian peppers.**  
Plant produces large 3-4 lobed fruits which mature green and chocolate.  
Distinctive jalapeno flavor without the pungent 'heat'.  
For the early garden. Blocky 3-4 lobed fruit maturing from green to bright gold.  
Large fruit & high yields, the best yet.  
Blocky, thick walled fruit turns purple when mature.  
Fruits have thick walls, mostly 4 lobed 4" x 3 ½" with smooth shoulders.  
Old favorite for pickling or salads. Green or red cherry shape 1" x 1½" fruit.  
Formula mix of the six most popular colors- lilac, ivory, gold, chocolate, orange and red.  
Four lobed blocky bell pepper.

---

Extremely large in size, ideal for Halloween display or pie use.  
Compact-semi bush. Pumpkins are only 30cm in diameter. Perfect for carving. Great for pies.  
True miniature. Perfect 3½" globe.

---

Slow bolting with small green leaves, perfect for salads.

---

Hybrid butternut. Vines are shorter and yields are heavy. 10-12" winter squash.  
Golden skinned zucchini. Long 20 cm fruits are slender and uniform.  
Light green scallop squash. Pan type.  
Smaller, space-saving bush plants. Great variety for gourmet 'Baby Squash'.  
Bright yellow, very smooth 5-6" long.  
Moderately ridged fruits, hard shelled and black green in color. Thick flesh is rich orange in color.  
Excellent novelty. Spaghetti like strands.  
Most popular courgette variety. Dark green fruits produced in profusion.

---

**Everbearing, compact, bushy plants produce large, deep red, full-flavored berries until frost.**

---

Main colors are yellow, gold, pink and crimson. Light flavor.

---

Indeterminate. Extra large beefsteak type tomatoes.  
Indeterminate. Fruits average 8-14 oz.  
Indeterminate. Heirloom. Deep pink skinned fruit with red flesh, 'distinctive spicy taste'.  
Indeterminate. Solid, crack resistant red fruits. Up to 1 pound, produced in great numbers.  
Determinate. Very large deep fruit are firm and exceptionally flavorful.  
Indeterminate. One of the earliest slicing varieties. Produces meaty, ripe, red fruits.  
Indeterminate. Cherry type in cluster like grapes.  
Indeterminate. Orange yellow large fruit, mild flavor.  
Indeterminate. Big red 4" fruits. Disease and crack resistant. Uniform fruit size.  
Determinate. Deep oblate shaped fruit-medium size-should be staked-good for tub/containers.  
Determinate. Pear shaped fruit 6-8 cm long. Used for paste and puree.  
Indeterminate. Heavy yields of smooth, meaty, solid fruits. 10 oz.  
Indeterminate. Clusters of very sweet cherry size fruits.  
Indeterminate. Excellent container variety w/high yields of bright red pear-shaped tomatoes.  
Indeterminate. Small, pear shaped fruit. Clear yellow, mild fruit.

Shiny, dark green, round 10 pound and up fruit with bright red juicy flesh.  
Delicious red fleshed 8 pound melons with extremely high sugar content and low fiber.
