

## COMPANION HERBS

<b><i>Herb</i></b>	<b><i>Companion and Effects</i></b>
<b>Anise</b>	Grows well with coriander, and together they are a good deterrent for snails and slugs.
<b>Basil</b>	Improves growth and flavor of tomatoes. Indoors repels houseflies. Do not plant near Rue.
<b>Beebalm</b>	Also companion to tomatoes. Improves growth and flavor.
<b>Borage</b>	Companion to tomatoes, squash and strawberries; deters tomato worms; attracts bees.
<b>Caraway</b>	Improves the growth and flavor of peas. Plant here and there - loosens soil.
<b>Catnip</b>	Plant in borders; deters flea beetles.
<b>Chamomile</b>	Companion to cabbage and onions. Improves growth and flavor. Tea is good for plants as well as people!
<b>Chives</b>	Loves to be near carrots, roses and apples! Makes them grow and taste better.
<b>Comfrey</b>	"Plant healer." Good garden barrier plant.
<b>Dill</b>	Helps corn, lettuce, cucumber, carrots and tomatoes.
<b>Fennel</b>	Plant this away from your garden - not friendly to anyone!
<b>Flax</b>	Protects potatoes against Colorado potato beetle. Also helps clay soil.
<b>Garlic</b>	Plant near roses and raspberries, and throughout the garden to deter Japanese beetles and other pests.
<b>Horehound</b>	Repels grasshoppers. Improves fruit yield on tomatoes.
<b>Horseradish</b>	Plant at corner of potato patch to deter potato bug.
<b>Hyssop</b>	Companion to cabbage and grapes, deters cabbage moth; keep away from radishes.
<b>Lavender</b>	Butterflies and bees love it! Repels rabbits, mice, ticks, moths and mosquitoes.
<b>Lemon Balm</b>	Plant with cucumbers and tomatoes.
<b>Lemon Verbena</b>	Repels midgies, flies, and other pests.
<b>Lovage</b>	Improves the health of all nearby plants. Invigorating to beans and sweet peppers.
<b>Marjoram</b>	Companion to sweet peppers and sage.
<b>Mint</b>	Companion to tomatoes and cabbage; deters cabbage moths; repels mice and flies.
<b>Nasturtium</b>	Companion to radishes, cabbage and cucumbers. Repels aphids, squash bugs and striped pumpkin beetles.
<b>Parsley</b>	Likes chives, tomatoes, carrots, roses and asparagus.
<b>Rosemary</b>	Plant near cabbage, beans, carrots, sage; deters cabbage moths, bean beetles, carrot flies. NOT near potatoes!
<b>Rue</b>	Likes roses and raspberries, disliked by cats and dogs. Incompatible with sage, basil and cabbage.
<b>Sage</b>	Good with tomatoes, carrots, cabbage and rosemary.
<b>Santolina</b>	Good with roses.
<b>Southernwood</b>	Companion to cabbage; deters cabbage moth.
<b>Summer Savory</b>	Companion to onions and beans. Deters bean beetles.
<b>Thyme</b>	Good for most other herbs and veggies, particularly eggplant and cabbage.
<b>Valerian</b>	Stimulates growth of all other plants and vegetables in the vicinity; attracts earthworms.
<b>Yarrow</b>	Invigorating to cucumbers, corn, and other herbs; enhances essential oil production.
